Amendment to the Schedule

1.1 Clause 17 of the Funding Agreement shall be replaced with:

The planned capacity of the academy is 1374 in the age range 11-18 including a sixth form of 230 places and a specialist resource unit of 24 places. The academy will be an all inclusive school whose requirements for;
