Our onsite lateral flow testing programme has been up and running since early January and has been very successful in helping to keep staff and students Covid-free.

The lateral flow tests are quick and easy to undertake and will be fully supervised by trained staff. Many of you will be familiar with these tests as they have been used for community testing in Harrow. Students take a swab of their throat and nose. Results take around half an hour from testing and the school will inform you if your child has a positive test result. After the initial test, students will be tested two further times on the school site during the following days and weeks. Thereafter, families will be provided with home testing kits (these will only be available for students who have completed the onsite testing).
